A special meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Milford, Nebraska was held at the City Hall Office in said City on the 14TH day of May, 1999 at 5:00 P.M. Present were: Mayor Dean Bruha; Councilmembers Dorothy Bockoven, Scott Burroughs, Gary Cooper; Rick Fortune, City Clerk J. Elaine Plessel. Also present was Craig Bontrager

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in three public places; a designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Certification of posting attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to the Mayor and all members of the Council and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to the minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Mayor Bruha at 5:08 P.M.

NEW BUSINESS: Swimming Pool Employee Wages – Burroughs introduced Bontrager, President of the Pool Board. He advised that both Camille Troyer and Rachelle Shepard had talked to him and contacted other towns in this area as to what wages are being paid. Following discussion a motion was made by Burroughs and seconded by Fortune to set Camille Troyer's wage at \$6.25 per hour and to get job descriptions in place before next year. Roll call vote: Burroughs yes, Fortune yes, Bockoven yes, Cooper yes. Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Bockoven and seconded by Cooper to adjourn the meeting. Roll call vote: Bockoven yes, Cooper yes, Burroughs yes, Fortune yes. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 5:20 P.M.
