Project Title:	Welch Park Trail				
Project Description					
<p>The proposed trail is a non-motorized multi-use trail, allowing pedestrians, bicyclists and wheeled strollers. It will be constructed 10 feet wide with 6-inch-thick concrete. The trail will be located within the limits of Welch Park and also connect to existing sidewalks on Oak Avenue. The project site is located in the northwest portion of Milford. The project will begin at the existing concession stand and restroom building on the east side of the park. The trail will loop around two ball fields and will connect to existing gravel parking, playground area, picnic shelters, sand play area, and open green spaces. The area has existing trees located throughout the park and the trail route would be designed to minimize the need for any removal of healthy trees. Attached to the loop around the fields, a trail segment will head north from the northwest corner of the loop following the western and northern tree lines of the property. This segment of the trail will connect to the existing neighborhood sidewalks on the east side of Welch Park Road (a.k.a., 252nd Street). Total length of the proposed Welch Park Trail is 3,450 feet.</p>

<p>The trail will be entirely on property owned by the City of Milford, including street right of way and Welch Park. The property is in a portion of the southeast quarter of Section 3 and the southwest quarter of Section 2, Township 9 North, range 3 East of the 6th prime meridian in Seward County, Nebraska.</p>

8. All paperwork may be signed by the project sponsor, but the Resolution MUST be signed by the Mayor.

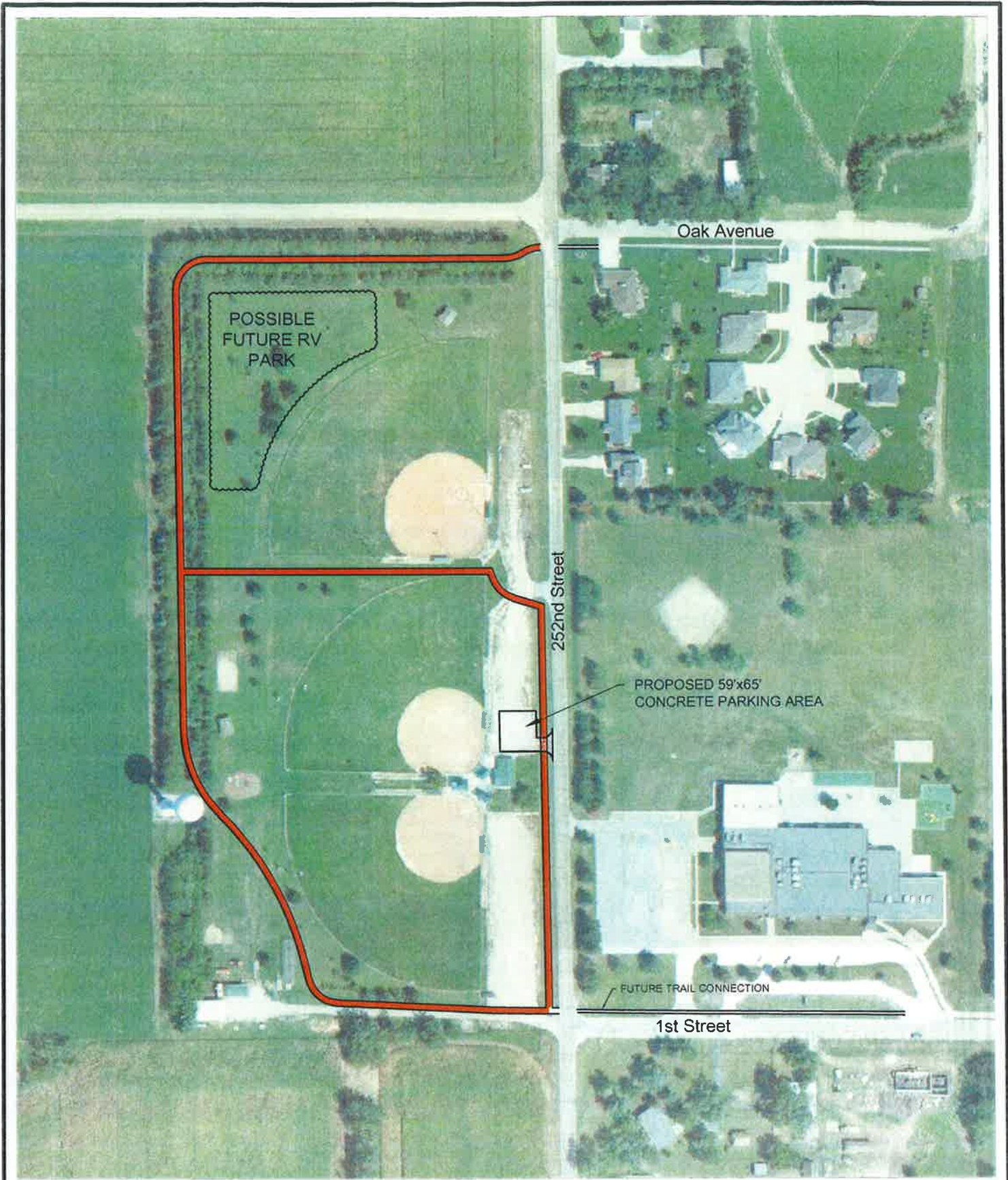
