Activity Report for April and May 2007 and MVFD Fire and Rescue NARSIS report for May 2007. Bruha noted that the maintenance dept. is experiencing equipment problems. They are down to 1 pick-up as of today. Sean Kremer arrived. The drainage project is near completion, but every time they seed it rains and washes the seed away. The alley between Maple St. and Walnut St. and 3rd and 4th St. was repaired and now has been torn up again to repair another sewer line. Mayor Plessel reported 18 runs on the NARSIS report for the month of May and read the Fire Report for April and May.

Proposal for New Building Official – **Todd Aerni:** Todd introduced Bill Fuelling, a coworker of Todd's that has agreed to pick up where Todd will leave off. Bill has agreed to accept the same contract as presented to Todd Aerni. Todd will transition Bill thru the month of June and invoice the City on July 15 for final inspections with NE Code Consulting. The City of Milford will need to turn all the electrical inspections over to the State of NE. The City has agreed to have Bill Fuelling present professional and liability insurance as part of the agreement.

Approve contract for new Building Official: A motion was made by Fortune and seconded by Bruha to authorize Mayor Plessel to sign the agreement with Bill Fuelling under the current terms effective July 1, 2007. Roll call vote: Fortune yes, Bruha yes, Baker absent, Neal yes. Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Fortune and seconded by Neal to adjourn the meeting. Roll call vote: Fortune yes, Neal yes, Baker absent, Bruha yes. Motion carried and meeting adjourned at 8:14 pm.
