PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION JANUARY 24, 2012 MINUTES

APPROVE MINUTES: Correct spelling of name. Motion to approve make by Ferrill and seconded by Kontor. Passed 4-0.

PUBLIC HEARING:

Item #1 Dairy Queen Drive-Thru

Mr. Anderson spoke against permit. Thinks it is spot zone commercial in residential and causing problems. Number of spaced needed 14 no 8 on diagram used as drive-thru. Drive-thru window limits lanes. Need to verify minimum width of drive thru required. Noise problems: Noise has increased since drive-thru; question locators of menu sign and noise from it. Screening one cast lot line needed, but graveled farther in. At 8:09 closed public hearing. Motion made by Wingard and seconded by Wiley. Passed 4-0.

Recommend to city council to issue conditional use permit with the following conditions for consideration:

Parking on re-zoning on 8.03 would add two spaces. (show on survey)

Noise: attempt to minimize by volume control, angle, and planting of bushes along lot line. 6.06.06 good faith effort to work with neighbor.

Request: Recommend to City Council that bell 2 research noise regs for cities and drive-thru width, etc.
